Life Is In The Blood, HIS Blood!

Did you know the BLOOD of a Lamb produces anti venom and builds immunity of a sheep that has been snake bit and is the antidote for the poison from the snake bite? Isn't that amazing!! And as long as that Lamb is alive there will always be an antidote of anti venom for the sheep against a deadly wound from a snake bite! When you think about that spiritually it blows your mind how Gods ways are above our ways and his thoughts far surpass ours.

Thinking about it spiritually JESUS is The Lamb of God and His precious blood is the only anti-venom against sin. The blood of JESUS, the lamb of God and only sacrifice for the sins of mankind is the only cleansing agent capable of washing away sin!
